Each weekly camp is a creative mix of arts and crafts projects, free art play, story time, outdoor playtime and collaborative art. Our week long morning camp sessions begin June 6. We also offer a 3 days option (T,W,Th). Campers should dress for a mess and bring a snack each day. We only accept 8 children for each session, so please be sure to register early!

Adventure Island, Ahoy! Sail away with us on the high seas to a tropical island. We will study creatures of the sea, create coconut musical instruments, shell jewelry and sand castles that will never wash away.

Faces, Friends & Family Children will have fun with paint, clay and found objects as we read and share stories about families and friends—even our furry ones. Our creations will go home in unique memory chests that we have decorated over the course of the camp week. Please bring photographs of friends and family as well as family stories.

Faeries Realm Children will delight in this visit to the magical world of fairies. In this camp we will create sea, woodland and flower faeries, along with their faerie habitats, using glitter, sparkling jewels and materials from nature.

Jungle Safari Venture into the jungle with us and learn about the amazing creatures that call it home. We will roar like lions, stomp like elephants and make parrot calls to make our masks and sculptures come alive. We will also create scrapbooks of our jungle journey.

Magical Munchkins Young children love glamour and glitz! In this camp we will create magic wands, magic spell books and more using a variety of sparkling and reflective materials. As we glitter and embellish we also learn about color and light.

Prehistoric Pipsqueaks Learn about prehistoric creatures real and mythical in this fun and educational camp. Children will make dragon puppets, cast dino footprints and have fun imagining what life was like when dinosaurs ruled the Earth!

Snugglebunnies The perfect class for any child that loves stuffed animals or dolls! We will learn to sew (in an age appropriate manner) while making soft, cuddly beanbag friends, furry animals, rag dolls and other snuggly creatures.

Tails & Whiskers Puppies, Kittens & More! In this camp we will focus on our furry friends, making puppets, kitty masks, puppy paws and more! We will also paint portraits of our favorite pets.



Kid's Art Camp (grades 1–5), (grades 3–8)

The Katonah Art Center Kids' Art Camp is a great alternative to full-day summer long programs. Our small camp groups enable students to receive individual attention in a warm, family-like atmosphere. All of our camps are one-week sessions with half-day and full-day options. Groups are limited to 5–15 campers, depending on the topic. Campers should dress for a mess and bring a snack. Full-day campers should also bring a lunch. **Please note:** subjects listed are options – choose one subject for each half-day weekly session.

Art & the Elements In this camp, students will create unique works of art that can be displayed outdoors. Students will learn about the affects of wind and weather on art as they create a kinetic sculpture, wind chimes and more.

Candle Making Come learn the ancient art of candle making. Students will create beeswax, pillar and votive and dipped candles. We will also make a gel candle aquarium. This is one of our most popular classes, for both staff and students!

Cartooning If you enjoy reading cartoons and comic books, you'll love creating your own! Come learn about single and multiple frame cartoons and let your imagination run wild!

Embellish it! Needlepoint and Embroidery for Kids (Grades 3–6)

Needlework is an ancient art form that has been used to decorate everything from the drawing rooms of Victorian society to the jeans and jackets of hippies in the Vietnam Era. In this camp students will learn needlepoint while making a miniature wall hanging. Campers will also learn to embroider, embellishing a favorite shirt or pair of jeans with needlework, jewels and custom-made buttons.

Famous Artists This class offers young artists the opportunity to explore the history of art through hands on experience. Using a variety of materials, students will learn about the styles and techniques of famous artists and art movements, while creating their own works.

Fiber Arts (Grades 3–6) Explore the fiber craze! In this camp students will learn to knit, learning simple patterns and making our own scarf. We will also knit squares that will be used to explore the popular fiber art of felting, as well as many Shibori felting techniques.

Flash Animation (Grades 3–6)

Create your own cartoon! In this camp students will learn how to use digital drawing tablets to create their own characters and settings. Campers will then make a short animated film, bringing their characters to life with Adobe Flash animation. Please bring a flash drive so your work can be brought home at the end of the week.

Fun with Photoshop (Grades 3–6)

Create art using Macintosh computers, digital cameras, and Adobe Photoshop. We will let our imaginations run wild, morphing our photos into unique works of computer art. Children will learn to layer pictures, use filters, and manipulate color, size and backgrounds.

Jewelry Making Learn the basics of beading, wire art and polymer clay bead making while creating beautiful jewelry for yourself and friends. We'll make earrings, bracelets, necklaces, hair-clips and more.

Shadow Boxes & Collage Use the discards of everyday life to create unique mixed media collages. Create your own imaginary world inside a shadow box using a found objects, polymer clay, photographs, paint and more.

Make a Movie (Grades 4–8) In this camp each child will write an improvised script for their own mini-movie as well as assist and perform in the movies of their classmates. Each student will learn to edit their own movies and to add special effects. On Fridays, there will be an award ceremony and screening of all the student's movies from 6-7pm.

Mechanical Sculpture In this class students will use pieces of old toys, found objects and discarded machine parts along with batteries, to create moving works of art. Students may bring in any discarded toys, and/or machines parts for this class.

Painting, Drawing & Sculpture

In this class we will focus on the visual arts of drawing, painting and sculpture. We will experiment with charcoal, acrylics, watercolor and clay as we explore landscape, still life, portrait and the figure. We will have a clothed model present for the last two days of class.

Paper Making Transform scrap paper and junk mail into gorgeous handmade paper! Learn traditional paper making techniques such as making pulp, using molds, deckle and adding inclusions. We will use our handmade paper to make homemade cards on the last day of camp.

Pottery Come and learn the ancient art of pottery! Learn to hand-build or throw pots on the wheel (ages 8+ for wheel) and create various other projects out of clay. Let your imagination run wild. Students will be called to pick up their work after it has been fired. **Note:** Pottery projects from last summer need not be repeated.

Stitch it! (Grades 3–6) Children will learn basic construction and sewing techniques. Using these skills we will make projects such as tote bags, stuffed animals or simple wearable items. This camp will provide lots of fun for every student, giving them increased knowledge of how pieces are made and a great sense of pride in their finished work. Students should bring a sewing machine, if possible.

Stop-Motion Animation

(Grades 3–6) Bring collage to life with stop motion animation. In this camp we will create characters and environments from magazines, book illustrations, patterned paper and paint. We will illustrate our stories and narratives with stop motion animation. This class will be split between the art studio and the computer lab.

Theater Arts This camp is perfect for children interested in acting and theater design. Students will create one scene, designing a stage set, creating costumes, and learning basic make-up techniques. We will also collaborate to create a skit that will be performed in our set on the last day of camp.

Teen Camps for Grades 6+

The Katonah Art Center Teen Camp is a great option for teens that love art and might be too old for, or bored by traditional day camps. Each one-week session will focus intensively on a single topic. Our goal is to instill in each camper the skills needed to continue to explore the subject independently. Teen Camp groups are limited to 5 - 10 campers, depending on the topic. Campers should dress appropriately for art and bring a snack. Full-day campers should also bring a lunch.

Please note: Subjects listed are options – choose one subject for each half-day weekly session. Materials included for all camps except where noted in class descriptions.

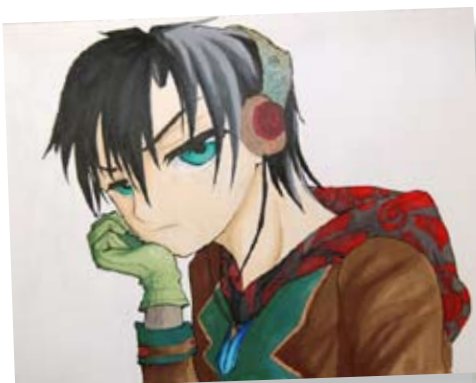

Art Journals / Bookbinding This camp is the ultimate in creative expression! We will bind our own books creating beautiful Art Journals. Using collages, drawings, pen and ink, and paint students will learn to express themselves through art and writing. This is a valuable skill for teenagers and one that can become a lifelong creative outlet.

Darkroom Photography In this camp students will be introduced to basic black & white photographic procedures. Students will learn how to meter for proper exposure, process their own film, and print their own images in our darkroom. Experienced darkroom students are welcome. Students must provide their own materials, call for a materials list.

Digital Photography Students will learn how to compose interesting shots, how to use light, and how to play with the photos they take using photo editing software. They will also gain an understanding of the functions and features of their digital cameras. We will also have the opportunity to create stop motion animated movies. **Note:** Students must bring a digital camera with charged batteries, a USB and power cord and flash drive to transfer work.

Drawing & Painting This camp is for students who love art. We will focus on drawing and painting while experimenting with different media such as charcoal, pastels, watercolors and oil paints. We'll also explore different topics such as the still life, landscape and the clothed figure. Students must provide their own supplies, please call for a materials list.

Fashion Illustration This camp, intended for students who want to design apparel and illustrate designs, develops the skills and fundamental techniques necessary to draw a fashion figure. We will cover proportion and scale as it relates to the human body, how to draw figures in motion, clothing details such as ruffles, gathers and tucks and more.

Fiber Arts Explore the fiber craze! In this camp students will learn to knit, learning simple patterns and making our own scarf. We will also knit squares that will be used to explore the popular fiber art of felting, as well as many Shibori felting techniques.

Flash Animation Create your own cartoon! In this camp students will learn how to use digital drawing tablets to create their own characters and settings. Campers will then make a short animated film, bringing their characters to life with Adobe Flash animation. Please bring a flash drive so your work can be brought home at the end of the week.

Jewelry & Clay Silver Students will learn the basis of beading while creating earrings, necklaces, bracelets and more. Students will also spend one day working with Clay Silver, a media which is shaped by hand and kiln fired. The end product is 99.9% pure silver. Students receive their own tool kit that is theirs to keep at the end of the week. **Note:** There is a materials fee of \$50 for this class.

Make a Movie (Grades 4–8) In this camp each child will write an improvised script for their own mini-movie as well as assist and perform in the movies of their classmates. Each student will learn to edit their own movies and to add special effects. On Fridays, there will be an award ceremony and screening of all the student’s movies from 6-7pm.

Manga Learn the distinctive style of Japanese cartooning called Manga used in Anime films. In this camp students will learn to draw the stylized faces, wardrobe and body types typical of Manga. We will also cover perspective, background design, special effect techniques and body language as well as the history of Manga and Anime.

Mosaics Students will create their own designs and learn how to translate them into mosaics. After learning the basic techniques students will be encouraged to bring a small table or chest from home, which they can turn into a beautiful work of art.

Outdoor Painting Come experience the joy of outdoor painting. Students may paint in the medium of their choice, learning individually within the group setting. Students will meet at the Art Center 15 minutes prior to the start of camp for bus transportation to the off-site painting location, pick-up will also be at KAC. In the event of rain, students will stay at KAC to paint in the art studio. Students should dress for the weather and bring water, a snack and/or lunch. Students must provide their own supplies, please call for a materials list.

Note: There is a transportation fee of \$25 for this class.

Photoshop Effects Create art using *Macintosh* computers, digital cameras, and Adobe Photoshop. We will let our imaginations run wild, morphing our photos into unique works of computer art. Students will learn to layer pictures, use filters, and manipulate color, size and backgrounds.

Pottery In this class, our middle and high school students will hand-build and work on the potter’s wheel. Students can throw traditional pottery forms such as bowls, cups and vases and hand-build imaginative forms such as birdhouses, teapots or pitchers. Students with previous wheel experience also welcome.

Sculpture In this class students will experiment with several sculpting mediums. We will spend two days sculpting the figure from a clothed model while learning proportion, anatomy, negative and positive space, scale and texture.

Silkscreen / Batik Learn various textile surface design techniques including block printing, bleach discharging and simple screen-printing. Students will use these techniques on printable garments or accessories and to create one-of-a-kind fabrics.
