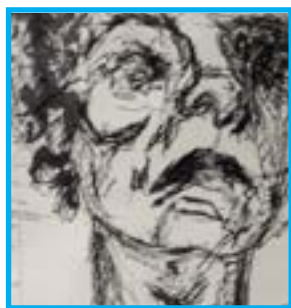
Learning the Basics with Expressive Art

Rembrandt van Rijn, *The Three Trees*, 1643

In this 4-week class, students will learn the basics of intaglio printmaking using drypoint etching. This classic method of printmaking was first developed in the 15th and 16th century by master printers including Albert Durer and Rembrandt. Participants will learn how to prepare their plates to create tone with a variety of mark making and values, ink their plates, and print with a printing press. This class is for all levels of experience.

Discover the fine art of printmaking with Monotypes. Monotypes are unique one-of-a-kind prints that use ink and a printing plate. Participants in this class will explore a variety of printmaking techniques with hand printing and the printing press. This workshop is ideal for all levels of experience, whether you are a beginner who wants to understand the process of printmaking, or if you wish to further your practice of printmaking.



Fabric Collage and Hand Stitching

Collage artwork created with hand painted fabric, fibers and embroidery thread. A variety of techniques of hand painted and printed fabric will

be explored to integrate into your work. Participants will be introduced to needles, thread and a variety of embroidery stitches to use as mark making to embellish their fabric collage designs. This class is for all levels of experience. Participants are encouraged to bring some fabric, thread, yarn, buttons, ephemera and a pair of sharp scissors.



Planting the Creative Seed

This workshop is for those who want to explore or renew their creativity. Whether you are a seasoned artist or a first timer, this workshop is a fun way to tap into the creative flow and see what grows. We will begin laying the ground using watery mediums, inks, and acrylics on watercolor paper and then layering with oil pastels, collage, or pencil. We will plant the seeds with color and cultivate them with texture to see what blooms.

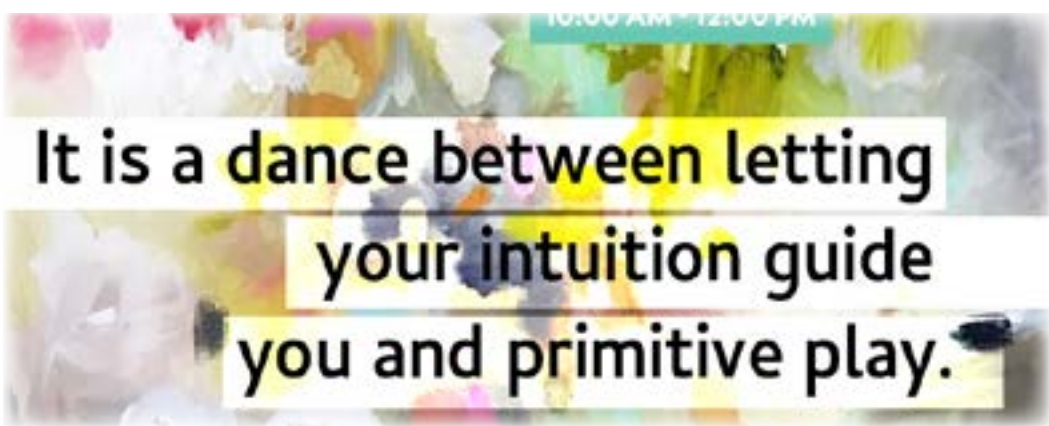


Art Journaling with Theresa Bates
