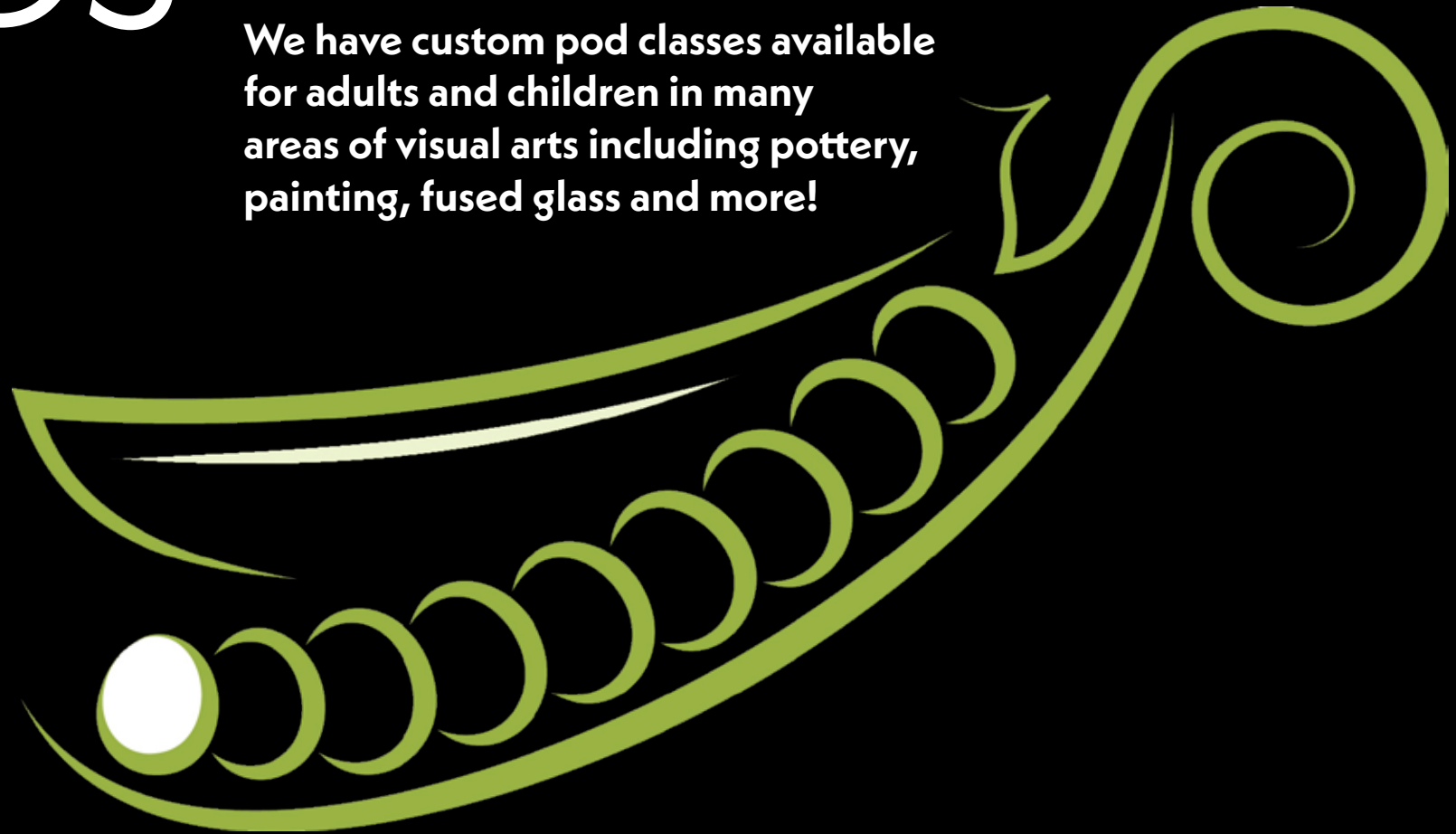

ART PODS

Have you created a pod?

If you have made a "pod" for a homeschool group or adult group and are looking to have an art class once a week with your group, reach out to us and we can make that happen.

We have custom pod classes available for adults and children in many areas of visual arts including pottery, painting, fused glass and more!



COVID-19 SAFETY PROTOCOL

All students, teachers and visitors MUST wear a mask at all times while in the KAC building.

The registration desk will be equipped with a Plexiglass barrier.

If at any time a student or staff member shows any sign of possible illness they will be asked to leave the premises; If a minor, the student will be separated and their parent or guardian will be contacted. It is the responsibility of the parent or guardian to promptly pick up their child.

The number of students per room will be limited to facilitate social distancing. Every classroom will contain four to six "cubicles" with plastic barriers.

Pottery wheels will be limited to 6 students, each wheel will be within a cubicle. Students are required to wash hands upon leaving their cubicle.

CLEANING: KAC will be cleaned and disinfected every morning by our professional cleaners. Studios and bathrooms will be cleaned during the day. Cubicles will be cleaned during the lunch hour to prepare for our afternoon classes.

SOCIAL DISTANCING: Travel throughout the building by students and other KAC visitors will be restricted. This includes but is not limited to halls, bathrooms, and common areas.

Use of the sinks in the pottery studio will be limited and monitored by a staff member. Use of the sinks in the art studios will be monitored.

SUPPLIES Students will be required to bring their own supplies, which can be purchased through KAC or elsewhere, as well as certain materials previously supplied by KAC such as paper towels and hand sanitizer.

Virtual students will have their supplies available for pick-up prior to the start of their class.

Students in classes where materials are not provided, must bring their own materials to class each day.

Paintings and drawings must go home with students at the end of each day. There will be no storage of artwork at KAC.
